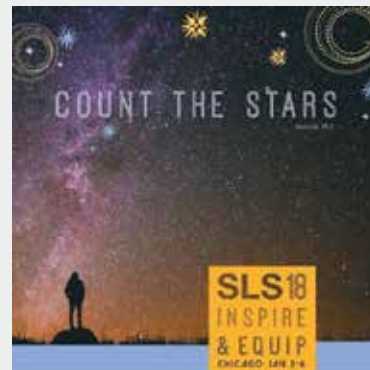

Newman will be showing the movie, Silence, in the media room. The story follows missionaries to Japan during a time when Christianity was not accepted. Snacks will be provided!

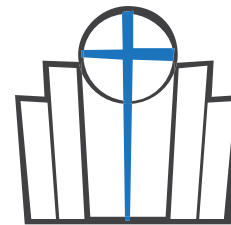
December 8: Christmas Bash
