He died for love while facing hate.

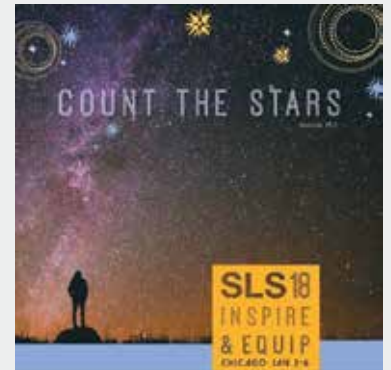
He did not run

#### Food Truck Friday w/ The Wesley Foundation: October 6 @ 4:30

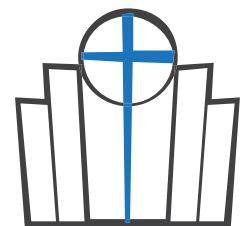
Newman has joined with The Wesley Foundation to bring together an evening of food trucks and lawn games! It will take place in the parking lot between Newman and Wesley. More details to come!
